### ABOUT THE EXHIBITION- "Land That I Love"

The City of North Richland Hills invites artists of all ages to participate in a special exhibition, *Land That I Love*. This show coincides with the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence and celebrates the enduring beauty of the American landscape. Artists are encouraged to submit works that capture the majesty of America's land and skies. In honor of National Parks and Recreation Month in July, we also invite creators to reflect on the "Power of Nature" through their artistic expression.

### **Submission Guidelines**

- Eligibility: Open to residents of North Richland Hills and the surrounding areas (all ages).
- Quantity: One (1) 2D or 3D artwork per artist.
- Subject Matter: Works must feature landscapes or outdoor scenes.
- Accepted Media: We welcome a diverse range of media, including:
  - Painting & Drawing: Watercolor, oil, gouache, acrylic, ink, graphite, charcoal, and pastel.
  - Print & Mixed Media: Printmaking, collage, and mixed media.
  - 3D & Craft: Sculpture, ceramics, metalworking, enameling, and textiles.
  - Digital: Photography.

Artwork must be framed or in a mat "hang ready" for a single wire system.

D-rings will not be accepted hanging techniques for this display system.

Artists, and their volunteers, are responsible for installing and deinstalling the work.

NRH Cultural Arts Coordinator will be available for assistance.
