The City of North Richland Hills invites artists of all ages from NRH and the surrounding area to submit one 2D or 3D artwork for consideration in a POP-UP Gallery exhibition in the NRH City Hall lobby.

As the seasons shift, so do our perceptions of light, shadow, and color. **Harvest Hues** invites artists to explore the transition of autumn through vivid, tactile detail, and bold expressive artistry. Share your love of the changing season as we celebrate Fall at the Hall with this special art show in the lobby throughout the month of October.

To be considered for this exhibition, works must prominently feature a palette of **strong, bold oranges and deep reds** – capturing the most vibrant moments of the autumn transformation. We are seeking works that embrace the energy, rich textures, and colorful weight of a season in flux.

Submissions celebrating traditional autumnal symbols, such as **pumpkins, gourds, and the conceptual essence of fall décor**, are also encouraged and can be interpreted through realistic or abstract lens.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Artwork must be "hang ready" in a frame, matte, or finished canvas edges for a for a single wire system.

D-rings or sawtooth hangers will not be accepted hanging techniques for this display system.

Small works may be hung with adhesive Velcro, upon confirmation with NRH Cultural Arts Coordinator.
